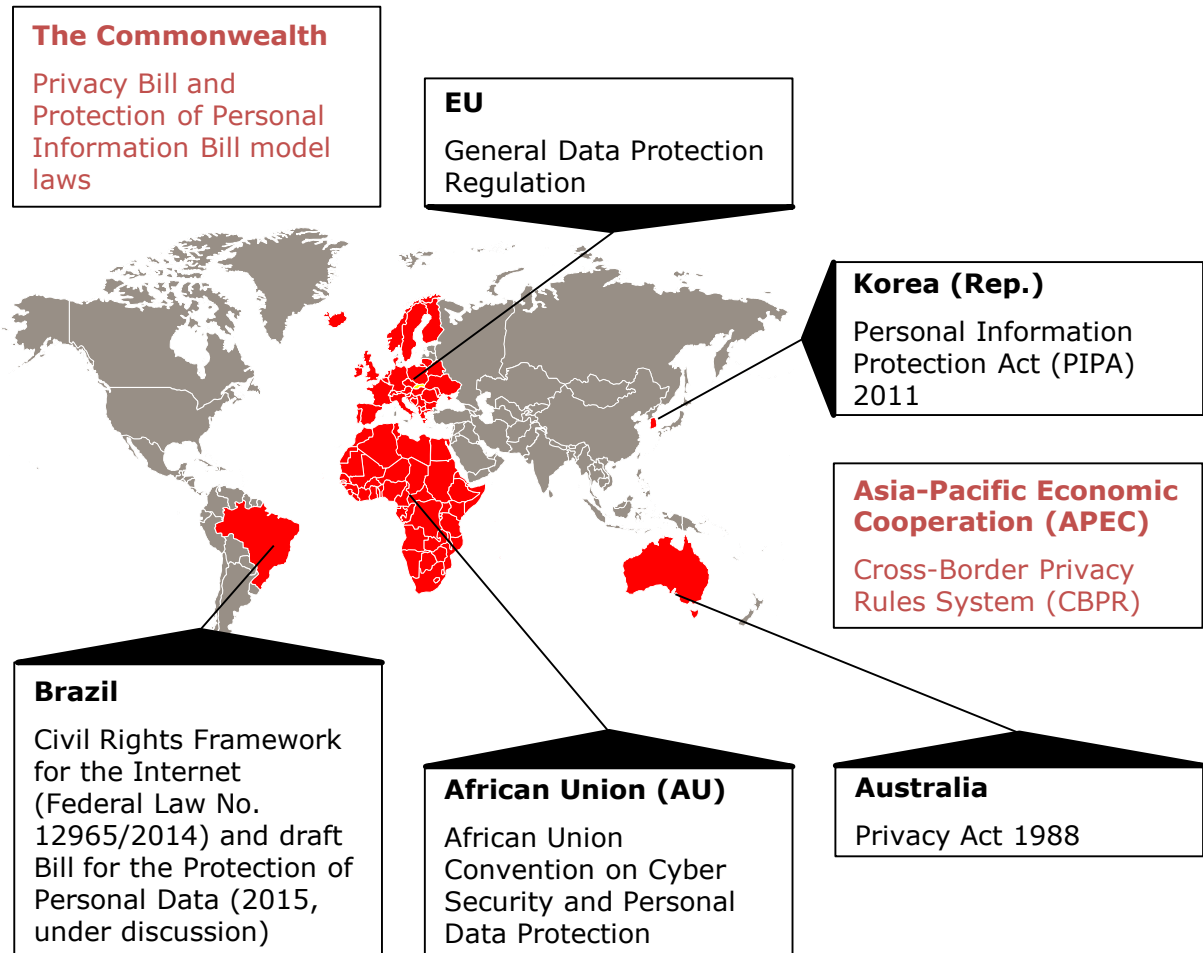

Key EAD milestones for Posts (designated postal operators)

New legislation

US – Stop Act - 70% of all incoming items containing goods by 31 Dec 2018 and 100% by 1 Jan 2021
Changes to UPU Regulations (article 8)
EU – ICS2, etc.

S9/S10 linking

S9/S10 linking (nested PREDES) will be required for all items (including non-tracked letter-post items containing goods)

Mandatory ITMATT

Mandatory ITMATT for all postal items containing goods

PLACI – ICS2 R1 (pre-departure)

EU Post at destination. Pre-loading item-receptacle level info needed for ICS2 (flows 1–7 of EAD model – pre-departure data sent by the origin Post, and relayed to ICS2 by EU Post at destination)

CARDIT conversion

CARDIT message must be converted to XFWB and XFHL cargo messages before filing to Customs (F42), from 2023

PLACI – ICS2 R2 (pre-arrival)

Pre-arrival consignment level for ICS2, from 2023 for airmail and from 2024 for rail, maritime and road (flow 8 of EAD model – pre-arrival data sent by carriers)

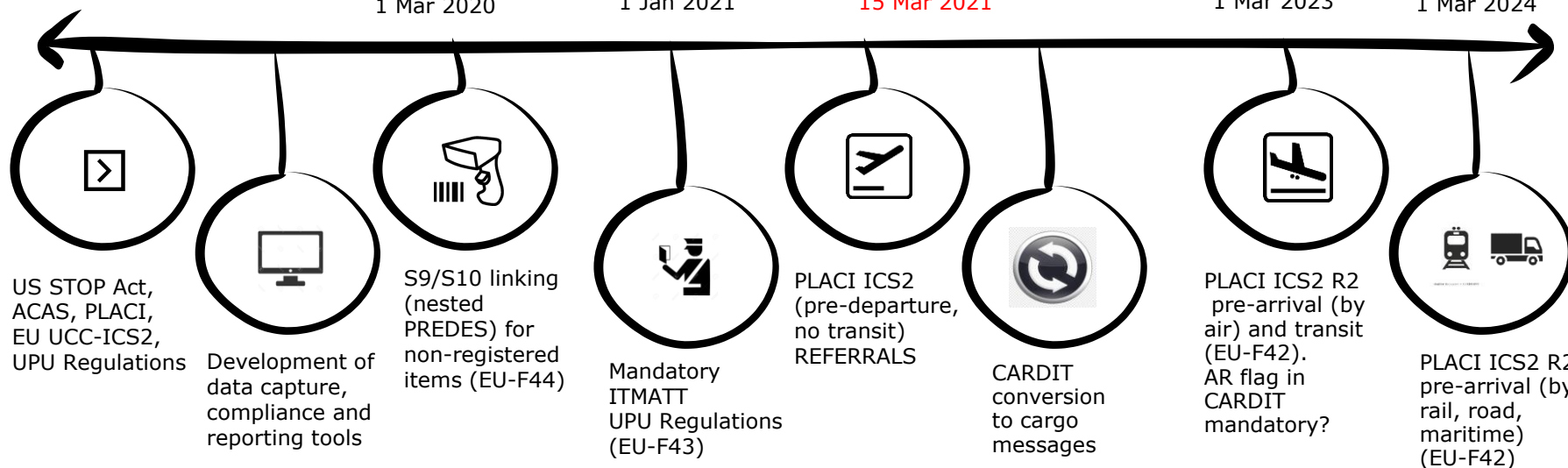

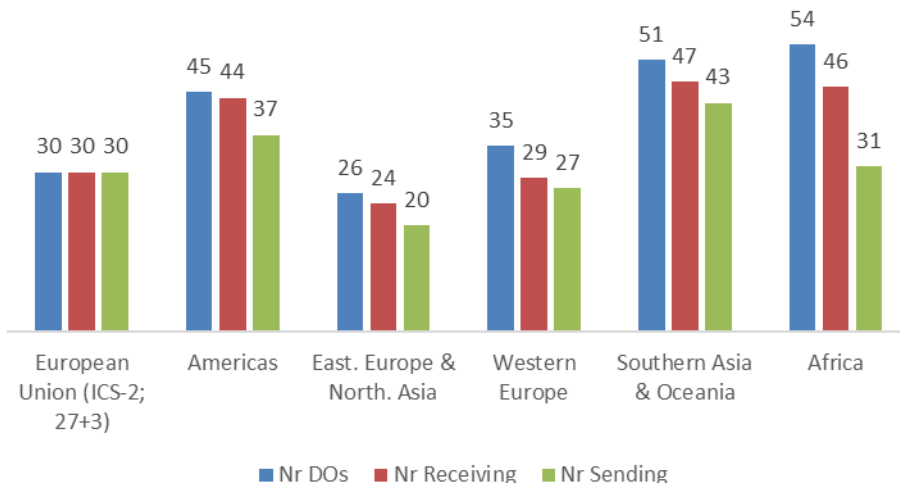

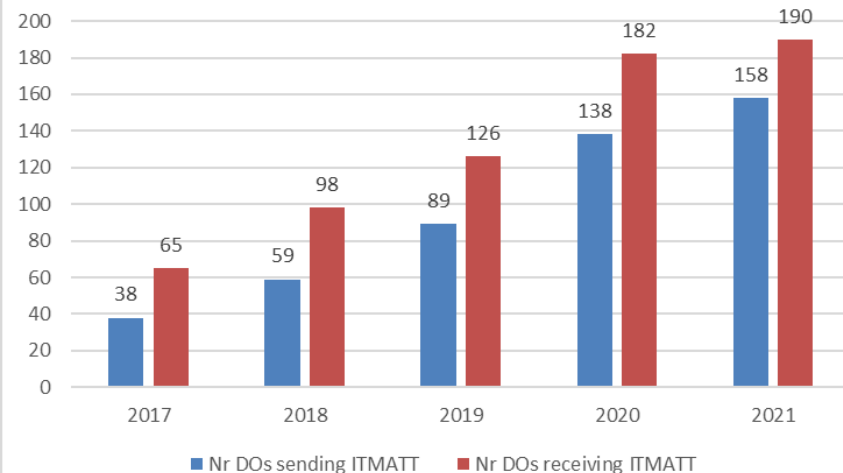
Progress in 2017-2021 with regard to EAD

- **195 DOs** are sending PREDES (Feb' 21)
- **190 DOs** are receiving ITMATT (Feb' 21)
- **158 DOs** are sending ITMATT (Feb' 21)
- DSAs, operational, IT and equipment-related issues are the biggest obstacles to faster adoption

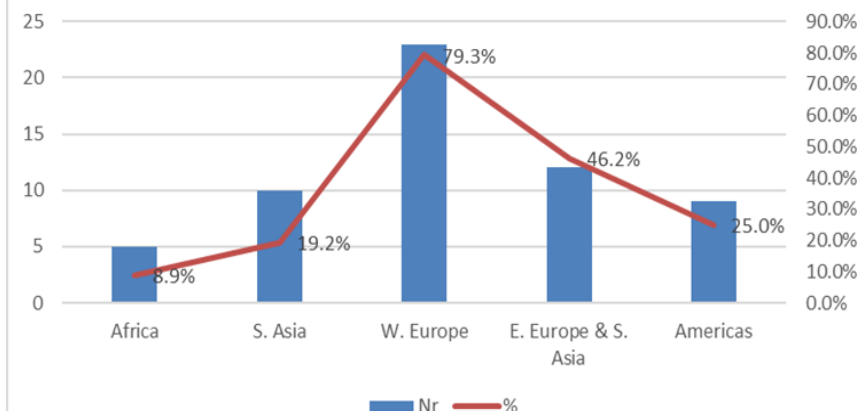
Operators exchanging ITMATT Messages

Evolution of ITMATT Dec 2017 - Feb 2021

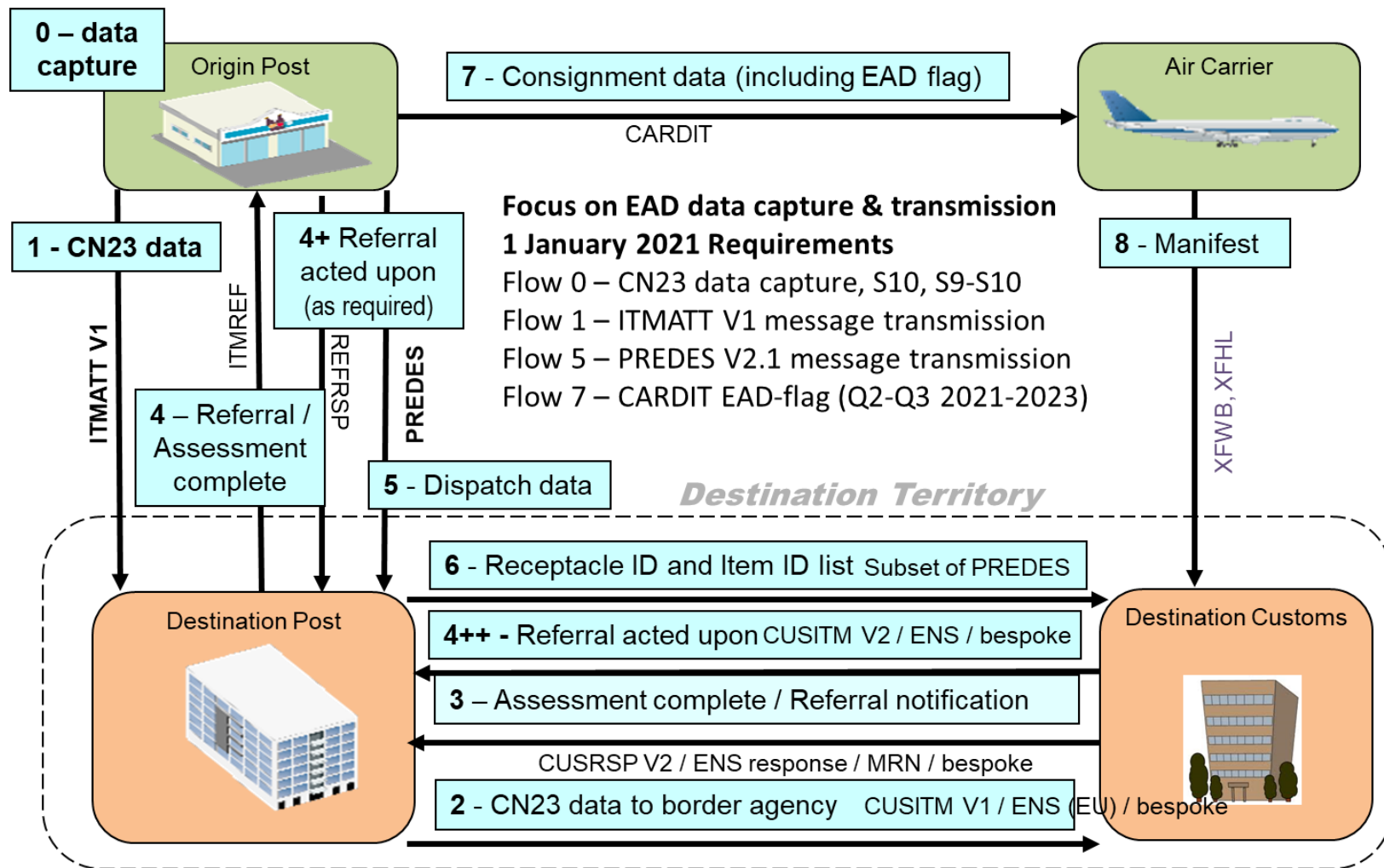


Interfaces with Customs by region (nr DOs, %)



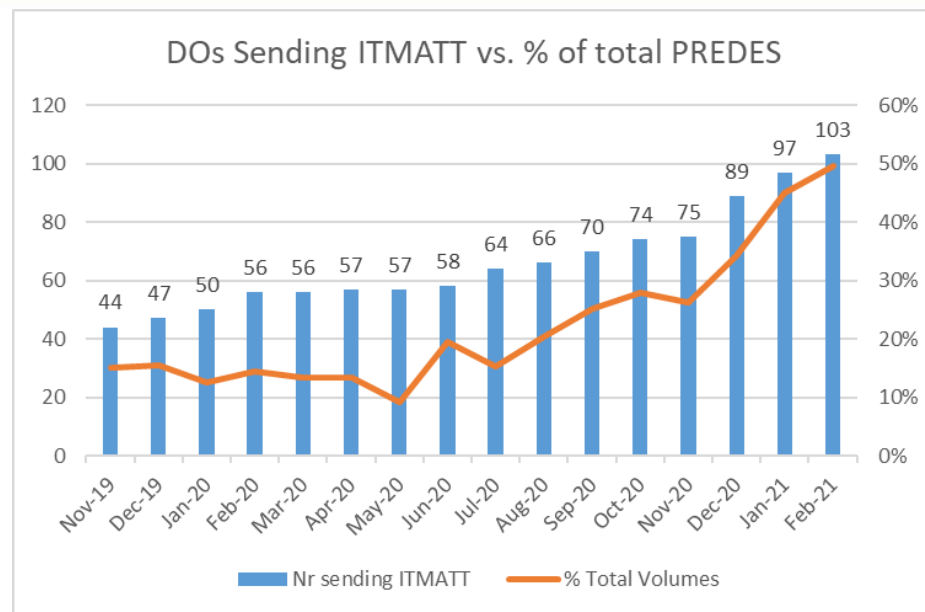


UPU Global Postal Model for EAD and PLACI (pre-loading advance cargo information)





- **143 DOs** participating in project

 - Increased from **44 to 103**

 - Increased from **15% to 50%**

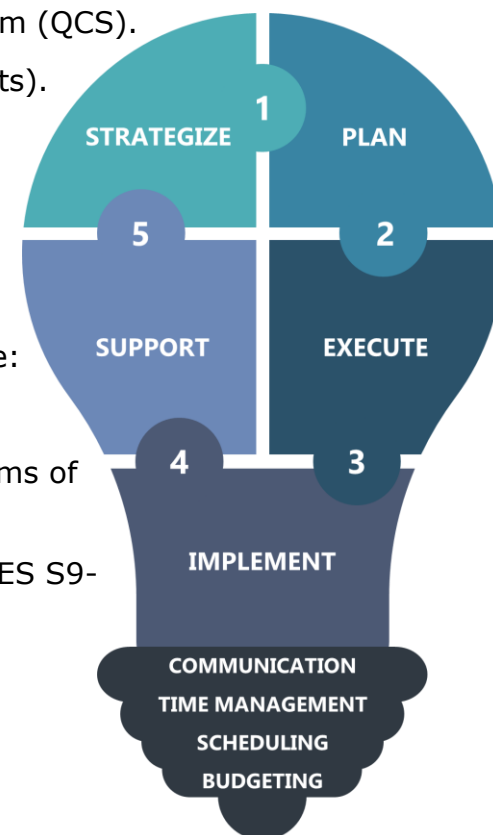

Focus on ITMATT and PREDES (S9-10) in Phase 1: proposed 11 steps

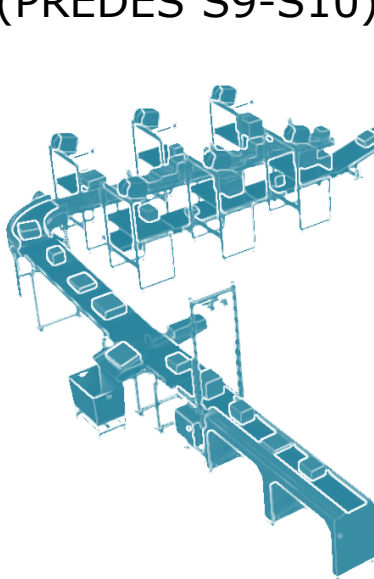
- 1 Prioritize top 5-10 partner destination/transit DOs (in terms of volume/requirements):
Using EAD Compendium (list of contacts and requirements), Quality Control System (QCS).
- 2 Sign DSAs as required with top 5-10 partner DOs (in terms of volume/requirements).
- 3 Enforce use of S10 and CN 22/CN 23 on all small packets at post offices.
- 4 Train staff to review correct completion of CN 22/CN 23/CP 72 at post offices: Use
WCO–UPU data capture guidelines for this purpose.
- 5 Roll out CDS/CDS.POST online training and production.
- 6 Ensure CDS.Web manual checks and data capture capability at offices of exchange:
 - By mail class (EMS -> Parcels -> Small packets);
 - By partner (start enforcing compulsory EAD with top 5-10 partner DOs in terms of volume).
- 7 Enforce IPS scanning of all small packets at dispatch at offices of exchange (PREDES S9-S10).
- 8 Plan the introduction of pilot post offices with capture of customer (sender) data.
- 9 Conduct procurement for pilot post offices:
 - Analyze providers and obtain offers, invoice and equipment;
 - Submit documentation (offers and invoices).
- 10 Train staff at pilot post offices to link customer data with S10/ITMATT.
- 11 Install equipment at pilot post offices and roll out pilot.





Possible EAD deployment strategy at offices of exchange

- 1 Roll out CDS/CDS.POST online training and production.
- 2 Ensure CDS.Web manual checks and data capture capability at offices of exchange:
 - By mail class (EMS -> Parcels -> Small packets);
 - By partner (start enforcing compulsory EAD with top 5-10 partner DOs in terms of volume).
- 3 Enforce IPS scanning of all small packets at dispatch at offices of exchange (PREDES S9-S10).

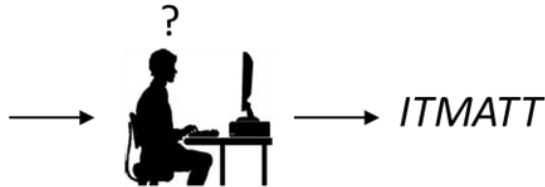


Pilot post office concept – declaration data capture at source

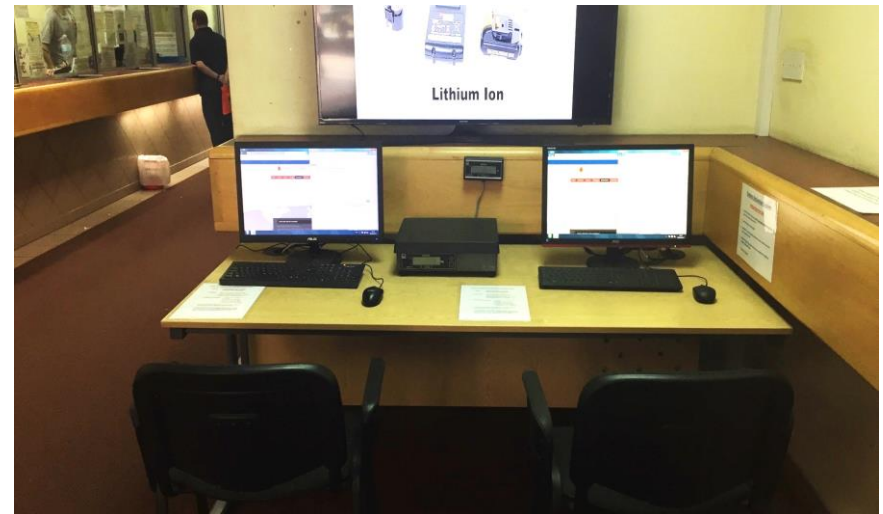
Focus on data capture at source, compliance monitoring and quality

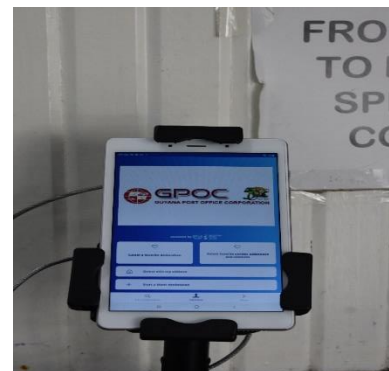
